Medic units should report with their company as time allows. Chief Officers, EMS Supervisors, Volunteer Companies, and Support Services staff may attend any session that their schedule permits. On the **BLUE** and **PURPLE** nights, members should complete the activities associated with those days below. The Health and Safety Bureau and Chief Officers plan to visit career and volunteer stations throughout the week to discuss ways to improve member safety.
