- geographic scope (comparable to the Washington, DC area)

The annual review/compensation process:

The chief executive officer, in consultation with the deputy chief executive, will determine compensation for staff based on the board-approved budget and comparable salary data for like-organizations. The compensation recommendations may include performance reviews, job descriptions, and other pertinent information. These recommendations are built into the budget approved at the NVFC's fall meeting. Annual salary increases are effective October 1.

The council's executive committee reviews and approves the chief executive officer and uses the same comparable data for management level positions as mentioned above. All discussions are documented via meeting minutes.
